YEAR 11 FINAL WEEK OF EXAMINATIONS ARRANGEMENTS - JUNE 2019

As we approach our final week of examinations, we thought that it would be helpful to simplify the information that we have already sent to you about when your child should be in school next week. You can see from the simplified overview overleaf that the final Period 7 exam warm up takes place after school on Monday 10th June, and your child will remain in school full time until lunchtime on Tuesday 11th June. Students will be dismissed at 12:20pm on that day. From then on, the times in which your child is in school will depend on whether they are in the S Band or L/N Band, and whether or not your child studies Geography. The final examination takes place on Friday 14th June and is Further Maths Paper 2.

Week beginning Monday 17th June

During this week, we have in place our final BTEC vocational intervention and our Sixth Form Taster sessions. If the BTEC intervention applies to your child, we will contact you directly. We will write to you next week with your child's personal timetable of Sixth Form Taster sessions.
